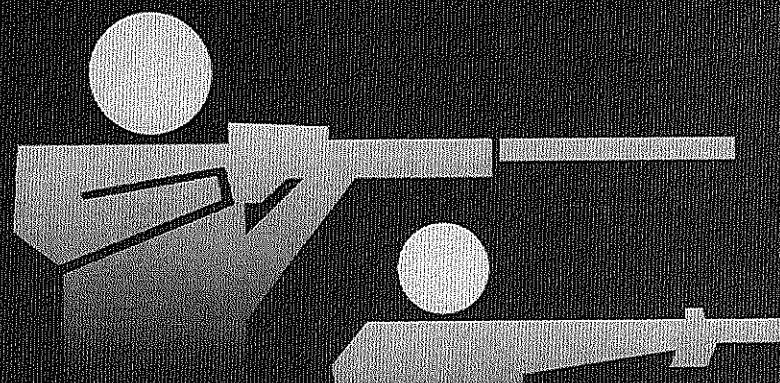


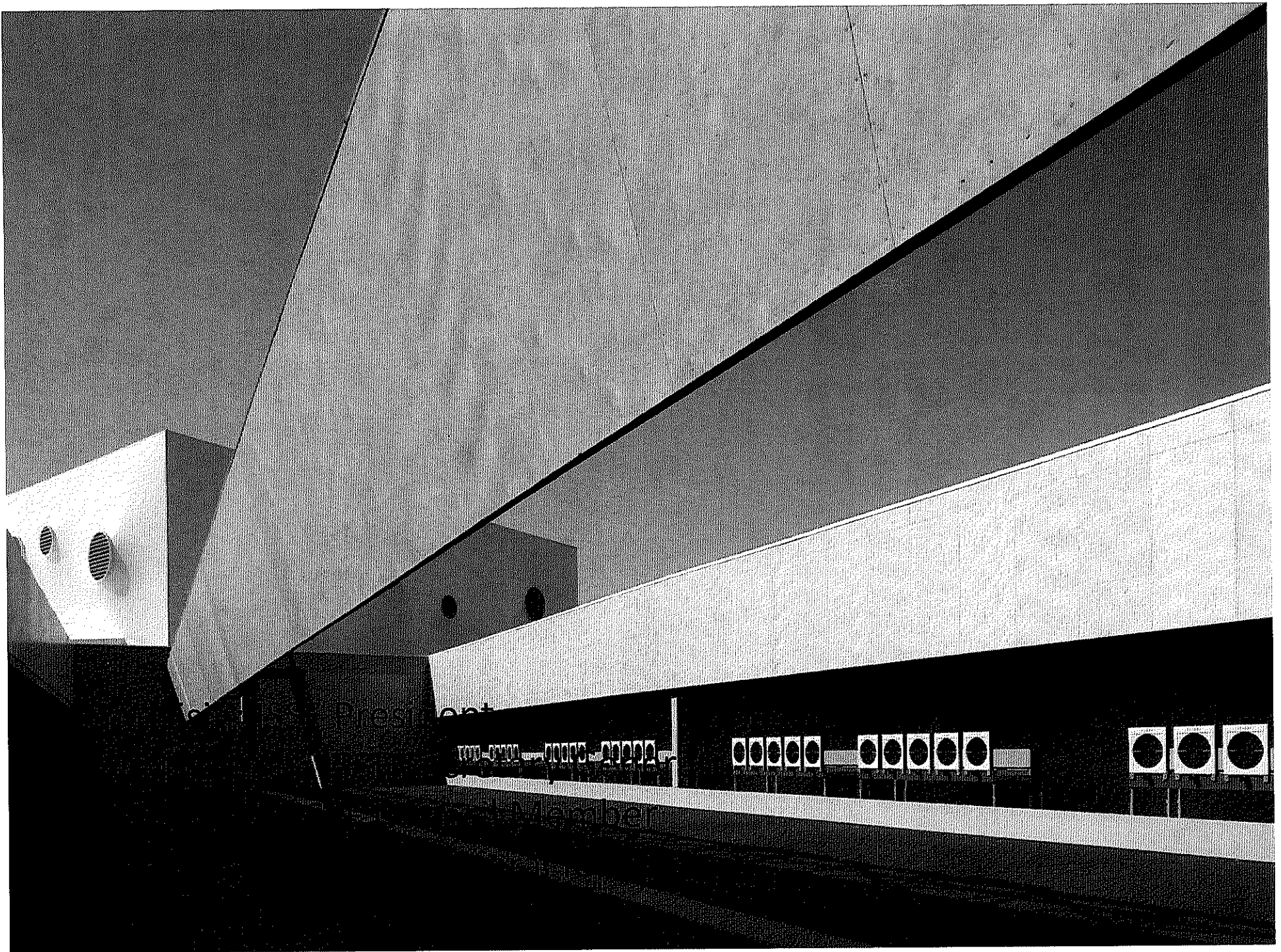

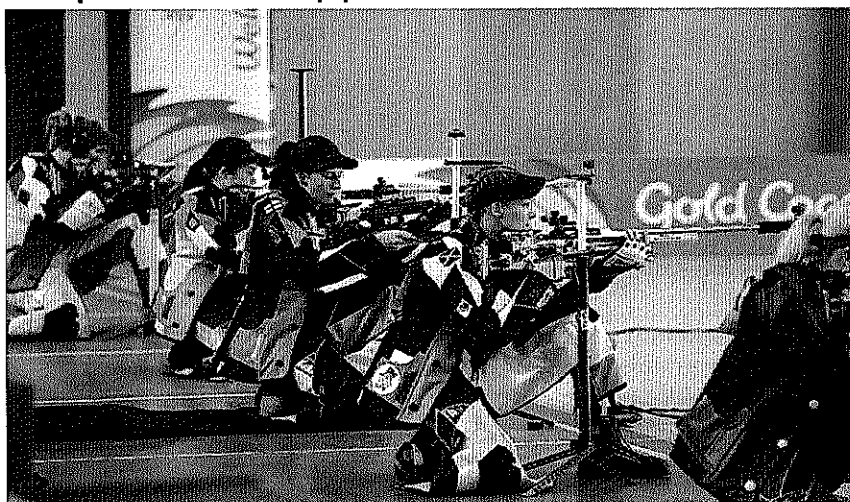

SPORT PROGRAMME – ENGAGEMENT AND APPEAL



- This represents the average traditional shooting athlete participation at past Games and expected 2022 quota of 300 athletes and 100 team officials;
 - All 5 continental regions and teams from 35-40 CGAs represented
- Agenda 2020 gender equality and Transformation 2022 in ISSF events;
 - 130 women and 140 men, with ICFRA FB 30 athletes gender free = 300
 - Men and Women compete with equal shots and same courses of fire
- Equal medal opportunities = 51

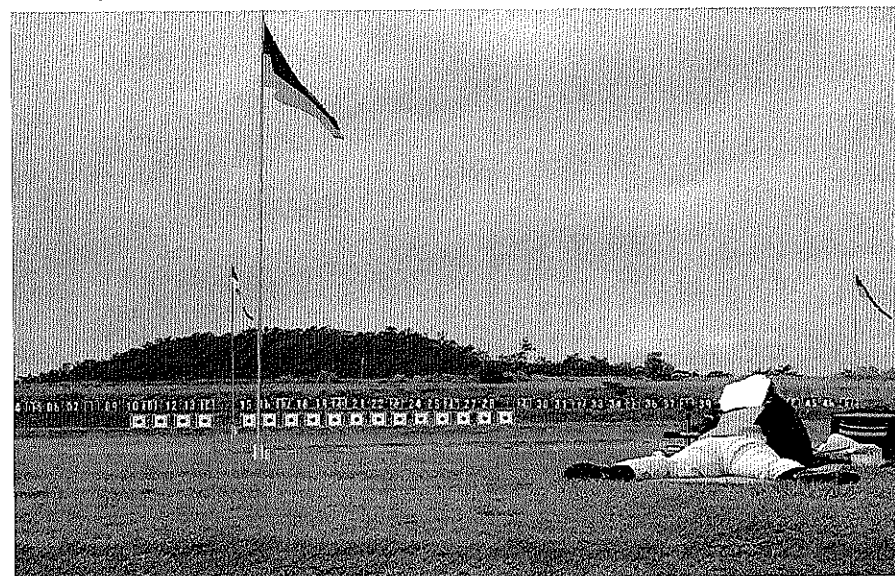
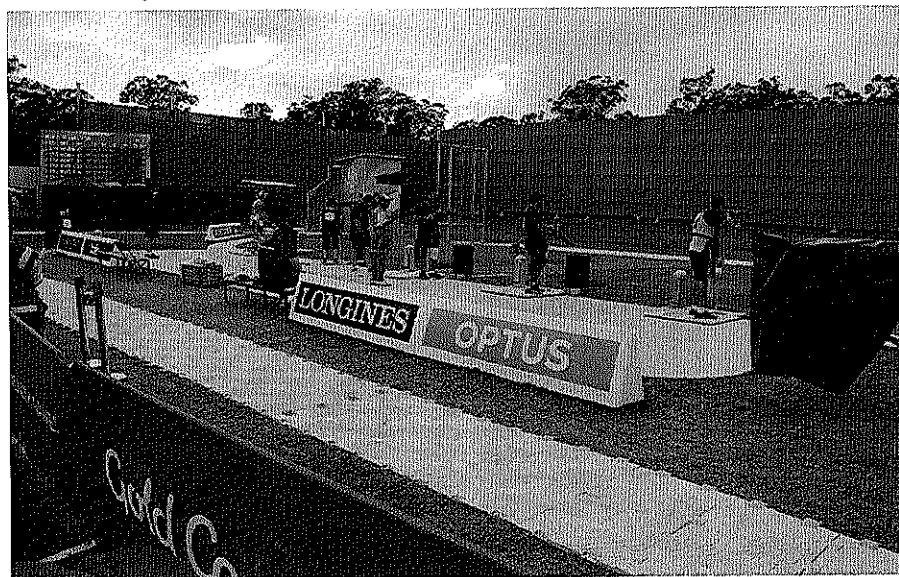

- Competition Format as for all ISSF and ICFRA Events
 - 8 Day schedule: 7 days competition and 1 day official training
- Unofficial Training for 5 days prior to Opening Ceremony (not customary 10 days)
 - Reduces venue operational costs
 - Athletes historic perspective
- Bisley and Fields of Play (FOP) compliant with ISSF/ICFRA technical rules and tolerances

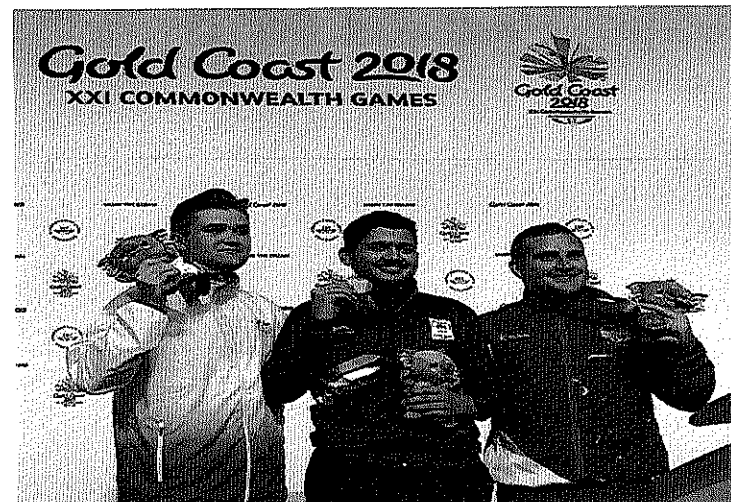

- The venue, ranges and FOPs fully comply with IF regulations, with upgrades

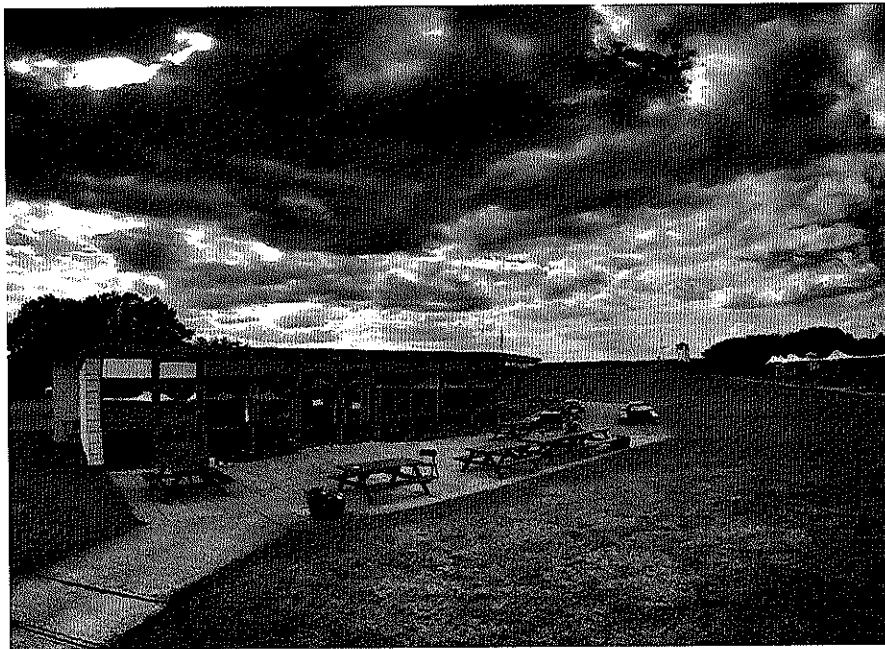


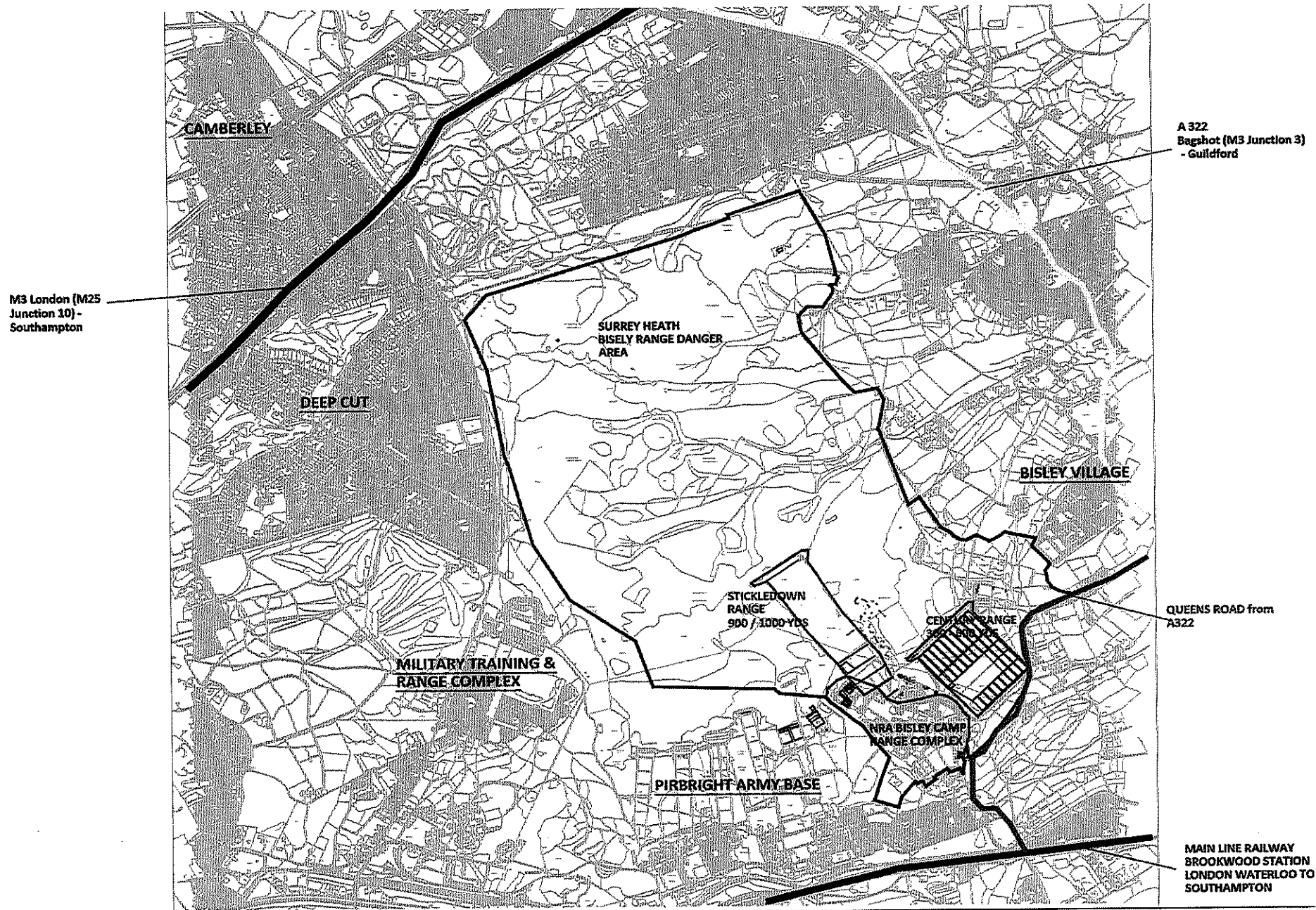

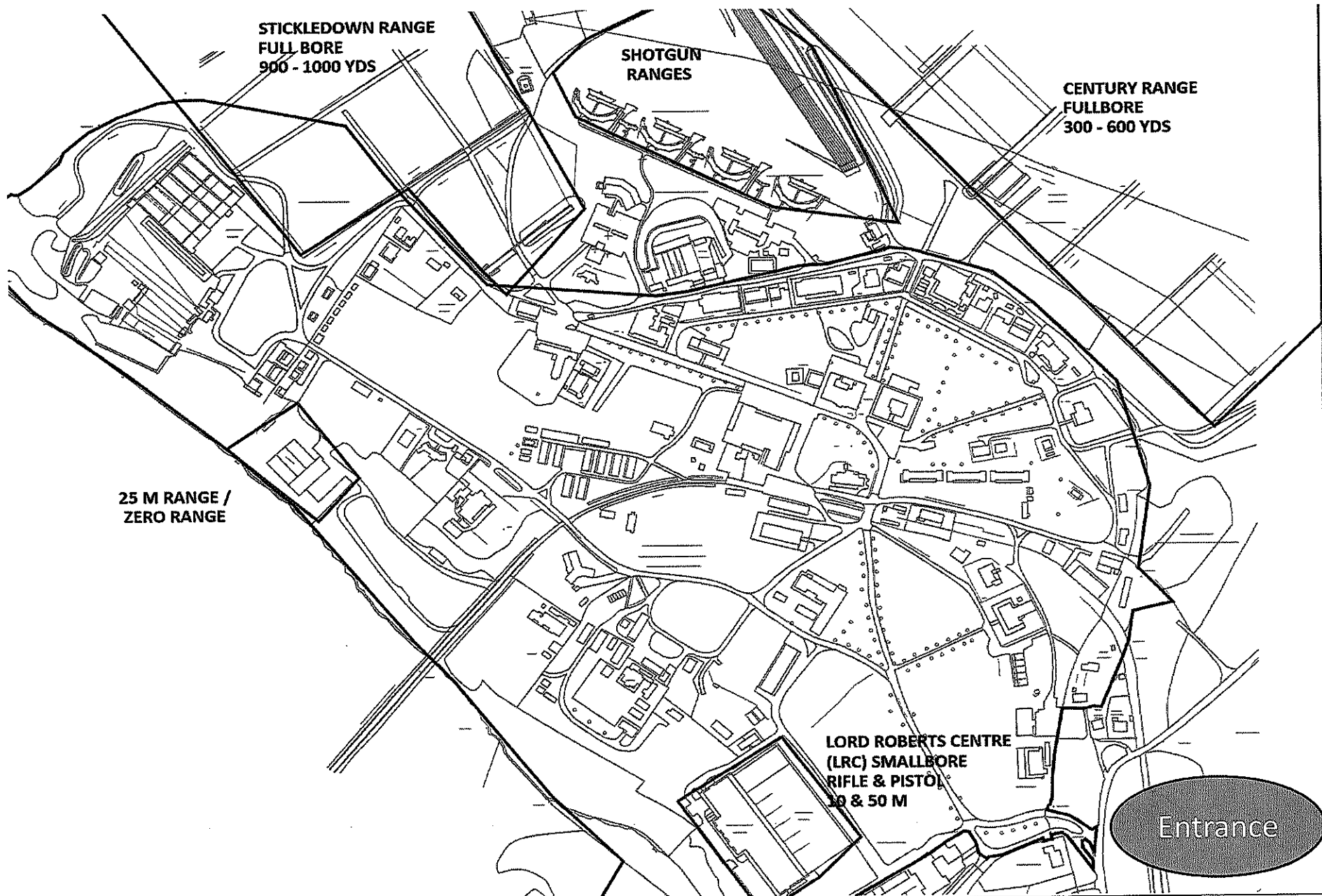

- Delivery template precedent as set for Manchester 2002, with enhancement



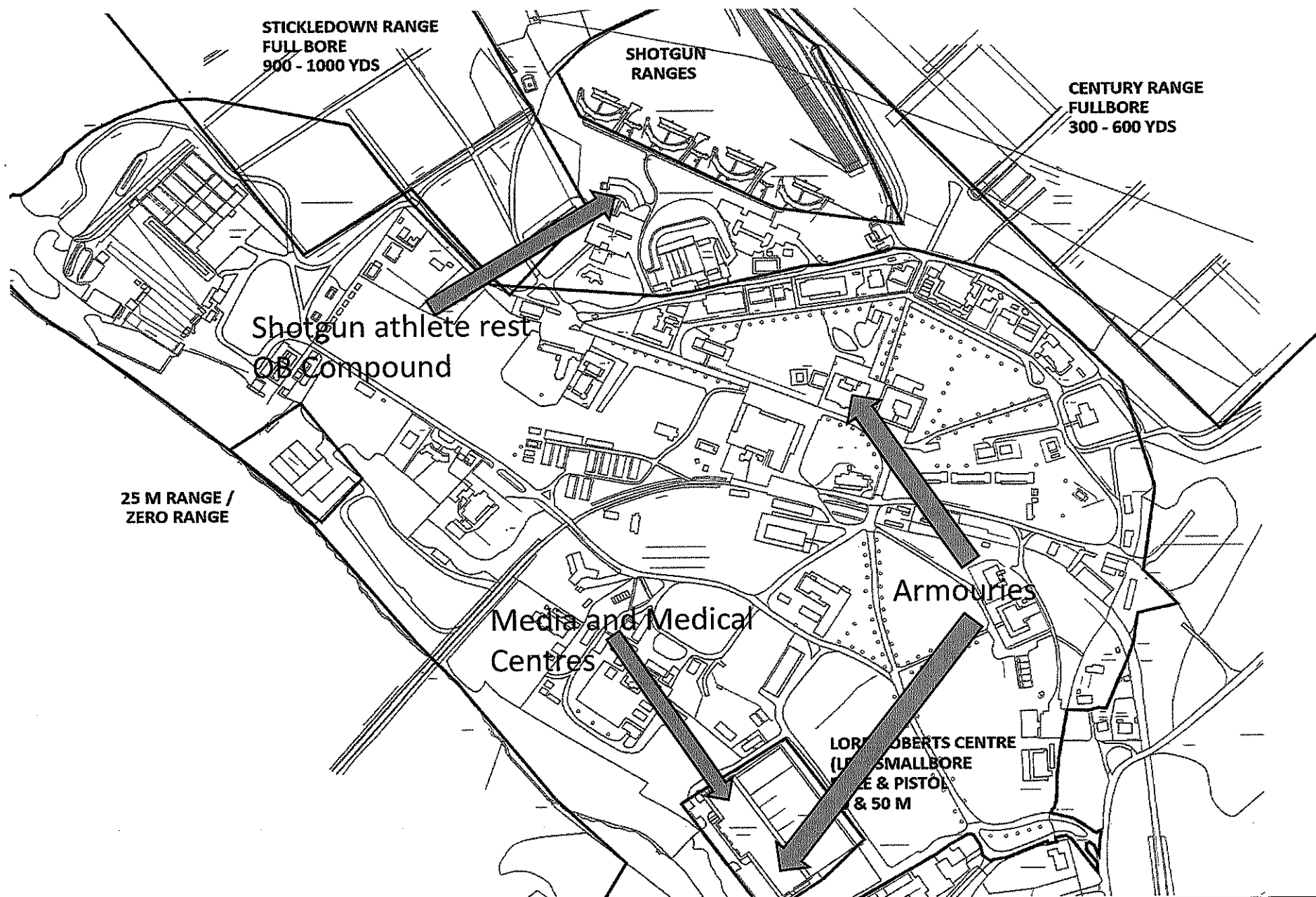


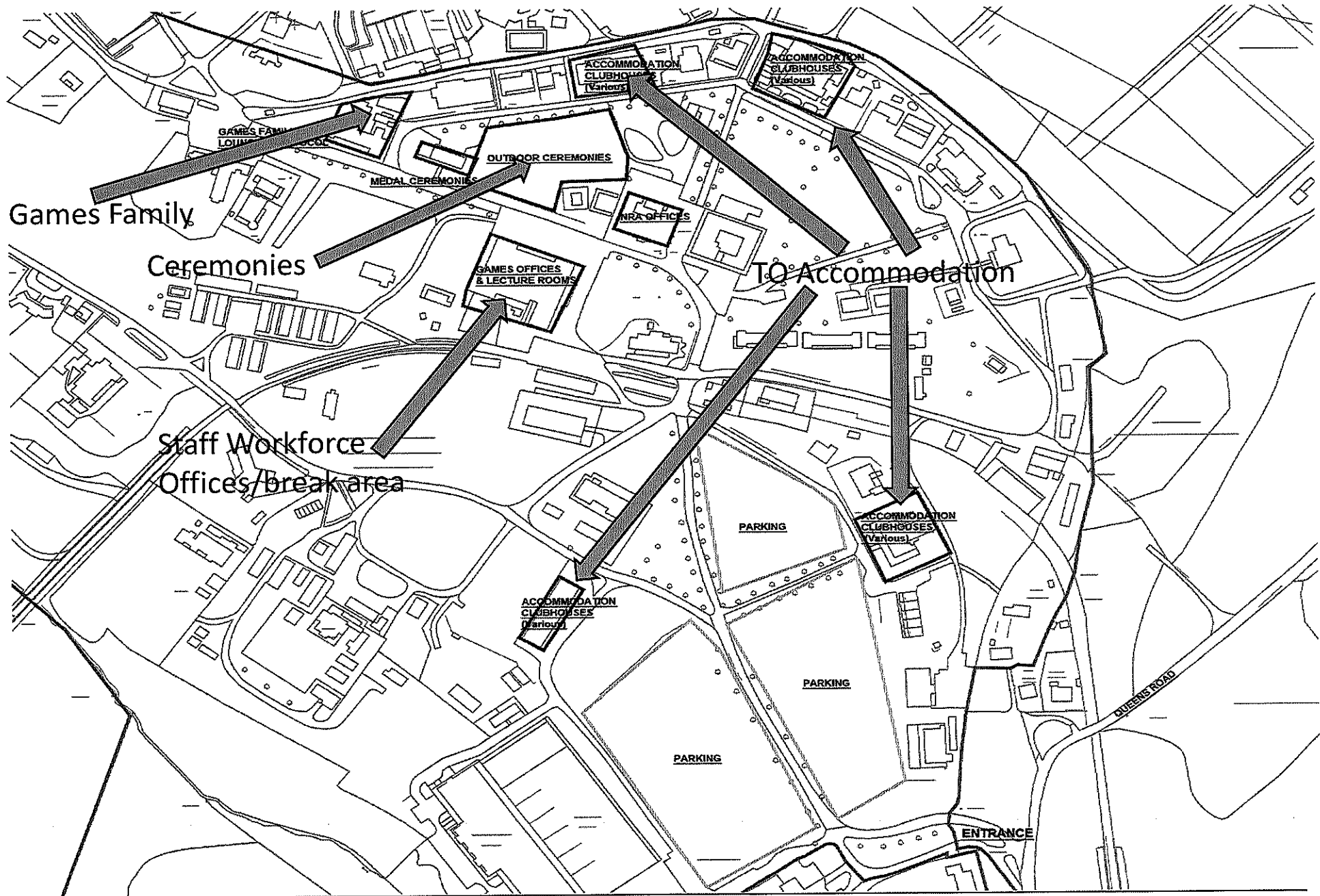
